You don’t have to be able to sew, to work with your hands. We also need women that will commit to *putting their hands together in prayer* for the needs of our ministry. Please pray for:

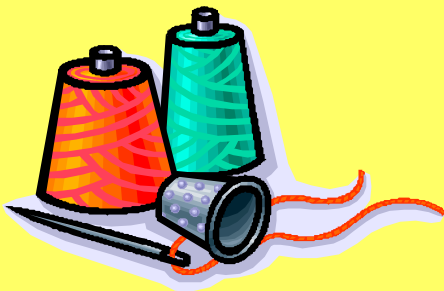
- ♥ Open doors for our ministry to grow
